We present below the notable resolutions, international treaties, and decisions adopted as of September 22, 2026. Please note that this newsletter is based on the date on which the relevant legal act was registered in the Unified Legal Information System, which may differ from the date on which the legal act was adopted.

I. STATE GREAT KHURAL: NOTABLE RESOLUTION

1.1 Return of Draft Laws

The Government submitted to the State Great Khural on June 4, 2026, together with the draft law on Business Freedom, the draft laws on amendments to the Law on Arbitration, the Law on Broadcasting, the Law on Radio Wave, the Law on Communications, the Law on Post, and the Law on Forensic Analysis. Based on the opinion and conclusion of the Standing Committee, the State Great Khural returned the draft laws to the legislative initiator.

II. INTERNATIONAL TREATIES

2.1 Ratification of the Financial Cooperation Agreement

Upon submission by the Government of Mongolia, the State Great Khural ratified on July 3, 2026, the "Financial Cooperation Agreement" entered into between the Government of Mongolia and the Government of the Republic of Austria on June 10, 2026.

III. GOVERNMENT OF MONGOLIA: NOTABLE RESOLUTION

3.1 Amendments to the Resolution and Its Annex

By amending the Government Resolution "On Approving the Organizational Structure and Staffing Limits of Ministries, Operational Strategies, and Programs for Changes to Organizational Structuring" the following changes were made to the organizational structures of the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change and the Ministry of Energy.

3.2 Approval of the Revised Procedure

The Government of Mongolia approved the revised “Procedure for Providing Monetary Incentives to Herders and Intensive Livestock Farmers Who Supply Raw Milk Compliant with Technical Regulation Requirements to Milk Processing Plants and Facilities” on August 26, 2026.

IV. MINISTERIAL ORDER

4.1 Approval of the Revised Procedure

- On August 11, 2026, the Minister of Justice and Home Affairs approved the “Procedure for Maintaining the Unified State Registration of Documents in the National Archival Collection”.
- On August 20, 2026, the Minister of Health approved the “Procedure for Conducting Examinations, Tests, and Diagnostics for the Prevention and Early Detection of Predominant Communicable and Non-Communicable Diseases Based on the Age, Sex, and Health Risks of the Population”.
- On September 4, 2026, the Minister of Roads and Transport approved the “Procedure for Registering Motor Vehicles and Issuing State Registration Plates”.

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
